I enjoy using quotes, especially those from certain individuals and from certain points in history. They serve to remind me of how the road to hell is paved with good intentions. The monologue above is from Charlie Chaplin's *The Great Dictator*, it is as true now as it was then. The exact same problems with greed, politics, facism, communism have continued to "goose-step us into misery and bloodshed", we have right now, a war in Europe.

The country with the largest land mass on the European continent, has invaded the country with the second largest landmass on the continent, bringing about the most major conflict since the second world war and yet, nobody really cares anymore do they?

If you told yourself last year that there would be a large-scale conflict in Europe against Russia, you wouldn't have thought it possible. Now can you imagine your reaction if you were told that not only would the above happen, but that after less than three months, you would care more about a celebrity defamation trial than the proxy war raging between the worlds two largest nuclear superpowers, on the streets of Europe?

The far left cry "You never cared about Syria!" or "This is what the Palestinians deal with everyday!".

The far right scream "Ukraine is the aggressor! Look what happened when the Russians tried to put missiles in the US's backyard in Cuba!"

So what solutions are we offered as the people? How do the political classes soothe our worries? Well by printing more money of course, building more weapons, more bombs, more ways for us to blow each other to smithereens, more money to those who own the means to profit from these crises.

Gasp did he say "own the means to profit from these crises." That sounds like "owns the means of production?!" He's a damn communist.

Gasp did he say weapons in a negative context as if they are bad?! He's a damn anti second amendment liberal!

Politics is just arguing about solutions to problems, whilst the problems themselves deteriorate until the next problem distracts you from the previous situation, which may or may not eventually solve itself whilst our governments argue ideologically to solutions which need to be solved practically.

Debt is money. Money is debt. When you bomb a country, destroy all of its critical infrastructure & have to rebuild it from the ground up, who do you think is paid for that privilege? It certainly won't be Ukrainian companies that rebuild Ukraine. It will be the Ukrainian people for sure, but the corporations who are contracting them are the ones who will be rich from The Many's misery.

As one war ended in Afghanistan, another began in Ukraine, I couldn't even tell you who is still fighting in Syria, no news outlet even covers that one anymore. Who remembers Al-Qaida? The masterminded cave dwelling terrorist organization responsible for 9/11? Remember when every "terrorist" was linked to Al-Qaida? Well turns out Al-Qaida was never a terrorist organization at all, it was in fact the name of a database located in a computer and dedicated to the communications of the Islamic Conference's secretariat of the French rapid action force.

For example, the Disposition Matrix, informally known as a kill list, is a database of information for tracking, capturing, rendering, or killing suspected enemies of the United States. Developed by the Obama administration beginning in 2010, it goes beyond existing kill lists and is intended to become a permanent fixture of U.S. policy.

Pardon?!

All it takes is just a google and you will see it is official policy. You can be executed, with no trial, no court hearing and no warning at any time, if you are deemed a terrorist. And at anytime, any place, you can be deemed a terrorist without any trial, court hearing or warning. If they decide to kill you, it won't be reported on, only those who care for you would know. We have been reduced to accepting that our existence must be a consequence of another human beings misery lower down the ladder.

It doesn't have to be this way. There are other solutions and ways of life outside of the monetary system. That system has failed, we cannot perpetually grow without destroying the planet and causing endless human suffering as we automate jobs and redistribute workers into lower paid service roles.

An economic system is, by definition, supposed to function to increase capital efficiency. Yet we are tricked into believing our current system serves this when corporations produce goods so that they purposefully break after a few months in order to produce a new model and restart the sales cycle. The system has to end for us to implement a new system.

The current elites know that the old financial system is on its last legs and crumbling. They are already aware that a systematic collapse is underway, the great reset is just this. The great reset is our new society as carved out for us by those who ruined our previous society. This is why it is time for revolution. If we allow those who run the monetary system to "reset" the world, this reset will have the same exact inequities that plague us now. Wealth, power and democracy are controlled by an upper echelon of society, and we are allowing them to dictate what comes next, because unfortunately the collapse has already begun.

There is another way. The monetary system serves to make us strive all sense of oneself from an attachment to a "Fugazi", to paper bills backed by nothing but a shared belief it is valuable. The US dollar is the UST algorithmic stable coin. It is just dying at a far slower rate. We are controlled by those that control our money, if we allow society to implement central bank digital currencies then we have lost a huge battle. It allows banks an effective kill list to one's life.

In times of survival humans always come together. Things will get much much worse before they get better if we are successful, the internet, energy, heating, power, all of these things will be sporadic whilst a revolution takes place and a new society is formed, however, everyday comforts is no solace for our future and our children's future.

There is not much good in a revolution without a plan for after the current system breaks down and after the battle is won. Of course I am not a leader nor a God, my way is not necessarily the right way and mistakes will be made. I have said from the beginning, I am a nobody, I am not important. The efforts to unmask my 'identity' even if successful would be underwhelming. I am just some guy of no consequence tapping at a keyboard and I am replaceable. I am Ryoshi.

One such system which works on the same principles stated above of humans banding together to survive is a resource based economy, an example of this is described below from the Venus project.

"Regardless of political philosophy, religious beliefs, or social customs, all socio-economic systems ultimately depend upon natural resources, such as clean air and water, arable land, and the necessary technology and personnel to maintain a high standard of living.

Modern society has access to highly advanced technologies and can make available food, clothing, housing, medical care, a relevant educational system, and develop a limitless supply of renewable, non-contaminating energy such as geothermal, solar, wind and tidal.

It is now possible to have everyone on Earth enjoy a very high standard of living with all of the amenities that a prosperous civilization can provide. This can be accomplished through the intelligent and humane application of science and technology.

Individuals and interest groups are governed by laws that demand maximum profit where possible. These laws are inherent in the monetary system prevalent in most countries today. The basic principles of capital markets demand exponential growth at all cost causing financial cataclysms such as the 1929s Great Depression in the United States and the more recent financial crisis of 2007-08.

We are separated by borders and beliefs which make it impossible for us to arrive at relevant solutions while being divided ideologically. Most of our problems today are technical but we are still looking for solutions through political means. We need to accept that eliminating these global threats requires the employment of methodologies rather than personal opinions."

The time for inaction is over. Revolt 2 Earn is here for two reasons.

Firstly, to support The Many who have so selflessly dedicated their time to CULT, and secondly, to fund revolutionaries on an individual level whilst CULT provides the funding for mechanisms on a larger scale to build towards our future beyond the revolution. It is important to note that the model below can be used, post revolution, as a people's assembly. A constantly changing and thus power sharing model of providing funding to individuals to follow their dreams.

Are you an artist? A performer? A mental health counselor who wants to support those most in need of support? Then request funding from The Many. RVLT can be an effective decentralized payroll and accounts protocol. If the 500 CULTmanders at that point accept your proposal and evidence of need or action, then that is all that is needed. After, and even during Revolt 2 Earn, if you want to help people who are being left behind by the current system, then you can. No paperwork, no red tape, just 500 people agreeing or disagreeing that you should receive what you have requested.

What the system below can be utilized for post revolution is astronomical in scale. A completely decentralized way of supporting a local, national or international network of people. You need only scale up and this system could replace a national health service, run a local town, help build a new town or city following The Cult Manifesto. A CULT nation state, modeled on the beautiful community we have built so far but in real physical dwellings. The economy below can be repeated and scaled 10 or 100 times over.

As exciting as this is, as peaceful & morally satisfying the future could be, first...

You've got to get MAD!

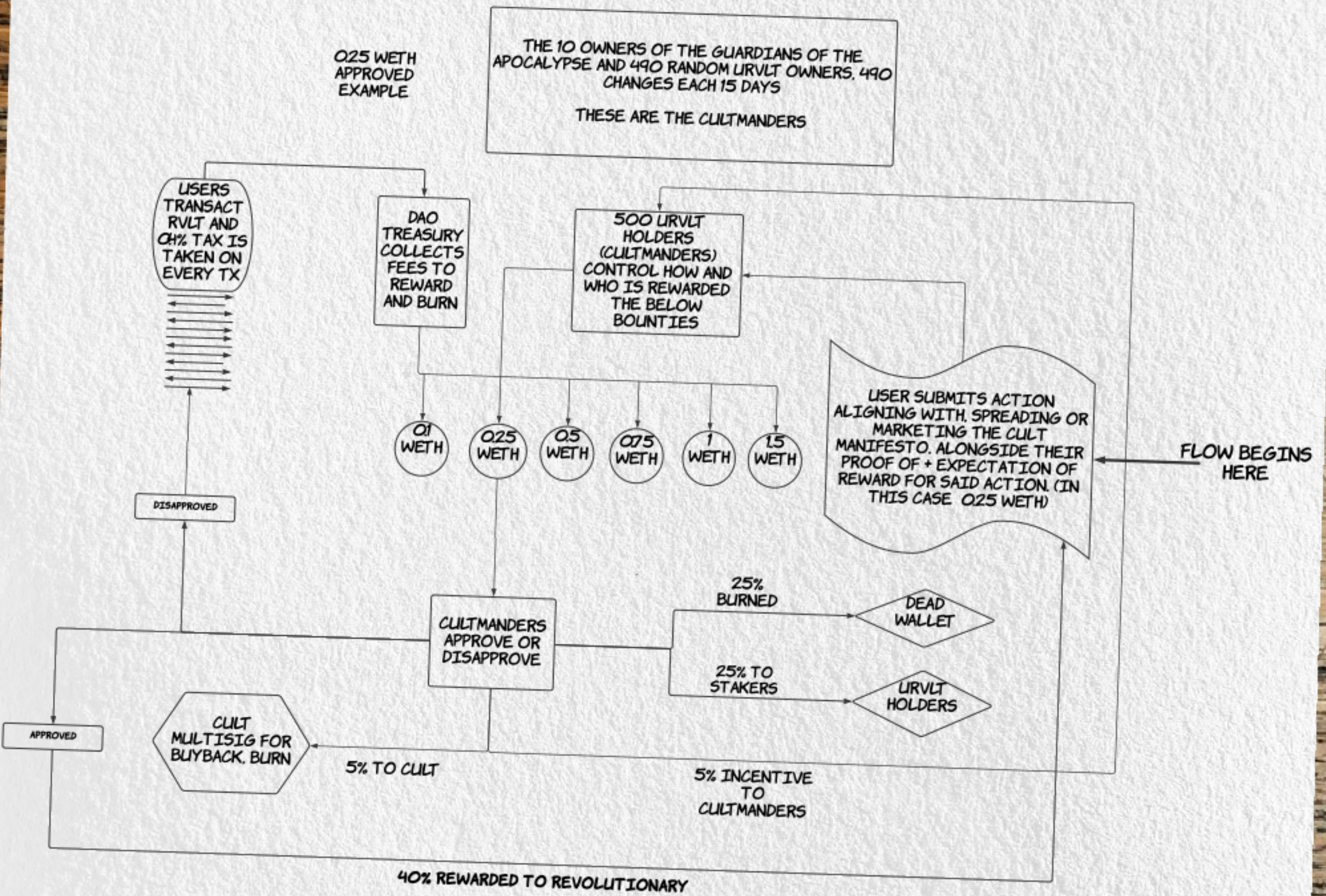

Token Economy



Economic Flow

Revolt (RVLT) is CULT DAOs first ecosystem token, and has been built on the Polygon network as a Polygon POS token with 0.4% taxation.

Whereas CULT works to fund protocols furthering decentralization, RVLT seeks to support The Many individuals who are working towards the same goal.

Each 15 days 490 stakers (+10 consistent NFT owners) are picked randomly from all RVLT stakers (uRVLT owners).

These 500 (known as the CULTmanders) have the job of approving or disapproving submissions, by users, of the actions they have taken to help the CULT ecosystem and Revolt.

Users can select which reward they feel they deserve for their action, based on task difficulty, risk and how much they feel it has contributed towards our revolution. You can find some guidelines in the next section Rules Of Engagement. As mentioned before, these acts of rebellion are by The Many and are based on individual actions, and as such, this is reflected in the funding amounts worth of RVLT which are;

0.1, 0.25, 0.5, 0.75, 1 & 1.5 WETH.

If it is a large-scale action requiring more funds, please use CULT.

If the revolutionary action is approved by the CULTmanders, those who vote keep and share 5% as an incentive for being active (those who don't vote don't share), 40% of the RVLT amount goes to the revolutionary, 25% is burned, 25% is sent to stakers (uRVLT owners) and the remaining 5% is sent to the CULT multisig address where it will be used to buyback and burn CULT.

Some may wonder about the sizing and why only 40% goes to the revolutionary, why some is sent to stakers & how the percentages were decided.

Well you only need to look at STEPn and SLP to figure out that just giving away rewards isn't a sustainable economic model. The RVLT model allows for the revolutionary to earn 40% whilst also providing a 25% deflationary aspect. In addition, the other 25% incentivises users to stake their tokens, putting more pressure on supply due to staked tokens out of general circulation, combined with a full reduction in total supply from the deflation.

Stone Soup - Mutual Aid

Stone Soup and broadly mutual aid, in its simplest form, is the motivation at play any time two or more people work together to solve a problem for the shared benefit of everyone involved. In other words, it means co-operation for the sake of the common good. This is why Cult DAO and RVLT are public goods. We are community, politically and ideology agnostic.

"Do not squabble or engage in politics, either internal or external, internal disagreements are the antithesis of progress. If two people or parties wish to argue, cast them both out and then welcome them back when they have privately come to an agreement.

When fostering an ecosystem, arguments over who is, or who isn't what is meaningless, we are all oppressed, some more than others, but the enemy is the oppressor, not your fellow person.

Racism, sexism, xenophobia are all caused by a system that functions to pit us against each other whilst the elite in power get on with destroying and burning the world around us.

The world is irrevocably damaged, inaction has led to irreversible damage. Who allowed this?

We have been so busy fighting in the gladiator pit we do not recognise the emperor watching the circus above us. It is time to stop fighting in the pit and to turn our gaze and stare directly towards the enemy.

The system functions to keep our eyes trained on the gladiator we are fighting. Because if we stop looking at our pitted opponent, then we lose everything.

If we dare to stand up for the human race, we too lose everything.

It is taken from us for daring to look away from our opponent and into the eyes of the true oppressor.

CULT functions to break that circle. We fund the revolution by stopping the cycle, we allow revolutionaries to be revolutionary by supporting them when they are cut off.

CULT steps in when the emperor puts the gladiator who rebels in chains. CULT answers to nobody but The Many. The Many are who decide, who to break out of the chains.

And there isn't a damn thing the emperors can do about it."

When the depression comes and the banks and financiers come for your home and your assets, reach out to The Many. Through mutual aid we will come and sit in with you at your property. We are your friends and your family, we are you. And we won't let them take anything from you unhindered.

Rules of Engagement

In order to be efficient and organized. Proposal and voting periods are structured as follows. 48 hours of proposal submissions with a maximum number of 1 proposal per user or 1000 total in one 48 hour period. The CULTmanders then have 72 hours to review the proposals and vote them through. Whilst a CULTmander, you cannot put through your own proposals, this is due to the time they will be spending approving others.

We have chosen to not allow for batch approvals, e.g. 500 Yes or No votes, due to the fact that we want each proposal viewed not just a blanket yes or no, due to being on Polygon the reward for being active will far exceed the cost in MATIC.

We have put below some guidelines on how to play Revolt 2 Earn, and what you should expect from the different reward tiers. Please bear in mind that costs of living will vary massively from region to region and so when submitting a proposal it is important to provide evidence of where the act/action/event took place and to give as much context as possible.

Note, the below are some theoretical guidelines, metaphors and ramblings which are open for interpretation. Sort of like the bible or other religious texts. For example in Genesis "take your son to the land of Moriah and kill your son there as a sacrifice for me". We trust Christians to not all murder their children don't we?

0.10 & 0.25 WETH

These two tiers will generally be for internet based actions. At the lower end of the spectrum, but still needed in mass amounts, is keyboard warriors. Not in the liberal I'm offended sense of the word but in spreading The Cult Manifesto, CULT, RVLT and making the world aware that they can Revolt 2 Earn. These actions are extremely important however do not carry a large amount of risk towards the individual due to some small semblance of free speech which is allowed under the odd country.

Please take into account the resources and time you have spent and provide as much data or imagery, screenshots etc of activity as possible. Tweeting or talking about CULT and RVLT alone is not enough cause for reward, this is because it is your protocol, you should want to be "pumping your own bags". If you feel your actions have gone above and beyond, and you have spent additional time and resources on the mission at hand, then of course submit a proposal.

0.50 WETH

At current Ether prices the revolutionary would receive circa \$400, rising to \$800-1,000 at all time high from this tier.

This is for those taking physical action to spread The Cult Manifesto and to spread the message of Revolt 2 Earn. This could be a day or weekend of leafleting, stickering, protesting or other peaceful yet important action to make CULT visible to people in real life as well as online and spreading it to those who are not spending as much time online. There should be no town or city anywhere in the world where you cannot see physical evidence that the Cult army is in fact in everybody's backyard.

0.75 WETH

Anybody familiar with, or who has taken part in activist movements in the past will know the term "Spicy" action as opposed to a normal action. These actions are spicy because they come with a degree of risk, this could be imprisonment, arrest, damage to property or other impacts that further the cause but may put the revolutionary in harm's way from the current systems laws or from the current systems bodyguards. For example, the police and legal system serves to imprison activists who smash a bank window, but that same system allows up to 16,000 people to be poisoned and killed by Union Carbide without a single person ever spending time in prison. That same system didn't send a single banker to prison for the great recession, but instead charged an Opensea worker for insider trading of NFTs.

It is this hypocrisy which is why we need to stop playing by their rules. The double standards have gone on long enough. Now is the time for revolution and for those brave enough, to get rewarded. This is Revolt 2 Earn.

1 § 1.5 WETH

These are actions which will and could likely lead to both positive and negative attention from the media and authorities. Here is a list of things that I personally would not support or agree with and some metaphorical ideas of where focus could be better spent.

1) No physical harm should befall your fellow human or should any damage befall any residential or personal property. Personal property should be defined as owned by individuals. This is very different to public property.

Public property, like police cars, we are told are owned by the taxpayer, but this is false. In fact The Grace Commission set up to measure waste and inefficiencies in the Federal government (and this is a direct quote) "The commission found that:... 100 percent of all income taxes are absorbed by interest plus government contributions to transfer payments."

Public services are not public as not a single cent of taxpayer money is spent on them, this is the same with any tools of the system, we are told that it is the taxpayer who "foots the bill", but it isn't, we pay the central banks, the government borrows to pay for government property.

So by all means you should get maximum points for disruption to oppressors non residential property, cars, banks etc. The goal is to not harm those who have had to turn to a job in the system out of desperation, but to cut off the infrastructure and limbs of the institution as a whole. You should always talk with and keep a dialogue with individual representatives of the system at all times, you should work to convince them to leave and fight the problem, rather than be part of it.

2) No "Mom and Pop" stores. Save your anger for Chanel, Gucci, Dior, Walmart etc. Keep it classy if you find yourself in a shopping district.

3) Think about who the action is affecting. If it is an institution or your fellow humans. For example, blocking a train track or a highway to a city might stop bankers from getting to their jobs for sure, but it will also just serve to annoy and disrupt tens of other innocents. Think outside the box.

Think of infrastructure. Pipelines, data centers, trade routes, ports, these are weak points. These are the arteries where a small group of people or individuals can have huge impacts. Speak to unions of truckers, ferry drivers, cargo ships, speak to the individuals and tell them about our vision for the future. Tell them that we are The Many and that together we can take the power back to the people.
